This term we will be concentrating on the EYLF outcome 2: Children are connected with and contribute to their world. We will also be having a look at Dinosaurs, as there have been a few children who have expressed their interest in this subject.

I would like to thank everyone who came and had interviews and discussed their child's learning. We really enjoyed connecting with families and sharing what we have learnt about your children.

We have a busy term ahead with our Transition to School visits beginning. We will be visiting the school on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> May and Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> June**. There is a letter (with more information) and a consent form to be signed in your pockets.

We have got a performance coming to the Centre on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> June**, called "Playing with Poems". There is a letter (with information and cost) and consent form in your pockets.

**Hats:** hats are not compulsory this term, but as we are still having some beautiful sunny days, there are some days (particularly in the afternoon) that hats will need to be worn. So please still put a hat in your child's bag.

On **21<sup>st</sup> June 2018** the Kindy will be having a student free day to attend a conference by Matt Glover on "Children's Identities as Readers and Writers". This is a follow up to a conference we attended last year.

We work with Child and Family Health to offer 4 year old health checks. This happens in term 2, 3 and 4. The first round will be on 21<sup>st</sup> May. I usually start with the oldest and work through the list of children. I will talk to this terms families about times.

**Rural Care:** the new Child Care Subsidy will be in place from the 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018. There is information in your pockets about your responsibility to transfer to the new scheme if you already get Child Care Benefit or Child Care Rebate. Please ensure you attend to this before 2<sup>nd</sup> of July or you risk being charged full fee for your Care.

Kindy fees for this term will be placed into pockets shortly. There are some people who have not paid term 1 fees. Please do so asap or come and see me about a payment plan.

We welcome back Ann to Kindy after her leave and Brogan back in the Rural Care program. We have a new student starting in Kindy this term, Tean. We welcome Tean and his family to our Kindy and community.
